

## Camera-Ready Guidelines

Dear Authors,

We would like to congratulate you for the acceptance of your paper. Your contribution will be very important for the academic community. However, to formalize the publication of your document on IET editorial, you need to comply with 2 phases, and submit your final version by February 16, 2025:

**Remember to make the corrections suggested by the reviewers before submitting your final version.**

1. Paper style adjustment according to the IET conference paper template and
2. Final version submission to CMT platform.

You must upload the article in .pdf format, in case you have used the Word template upload also the .doc or .docx file.

In case of using the Latex template upload the article in .pdf format and the source files in .zip format.

### Phase 1. Paper style adjustment according to the IET conference paper template

1. At this stage it is needed to adjust the paper style according to the IET format: Title, Authors, Affiliation and Keywords, see Figure 1. Note that:
  - Both title and keywords and in CAPITAL LETTERS
  - Authors are in **bold letters** and *italic letters*
  - Affiliations are in *italic letters*

**Keywords:** Enter a maximum of five keywords here (use style: KEYWORD ONE, KEYWORD TWO, ...)

#### **Abstract**

The abstract should be suitable for direct inclusion in abstracting services as a self-contained article. The length of the abstract should not exceed 200 words. Do not include figure numbers, table numbers, references or displayed mathematical expressions

3. Please, be attentive to the information of the authors and affiliations.
4. Use the IET reference style. Some examples are provided in the Word template. Users of Latex/Overleaf **are strongly** suggested to use the .bst file included in the Latex template, which is ready for using the \bibliographystyle environment. For example:

### Journal articles

## 5. Consider that you must adhere to the **Page Length**:

The paper should be between **4 and 6** double-column pages. Beyond this length, a charge per additional page will be applied. The maximum number of pages allowed is **8**.

Please, go to the ICTIAIR 2025 web page on <https://ictiair.tiacon.org/> to download the paper templates in the Menu “For Authors/Templates”. Papers without following the required formatting will not be published in the conference proceedings.

## Phase 2. Final version submission on CMT platform

1. Login to the submission center CMT through the ICTIAIR 2025 web page on <https://ictiair.tiacon.org/> in the Menu “For Authors/ Submit your paper”, or go directly on <https://shorturl.at/5roLU> , see Figure 2.

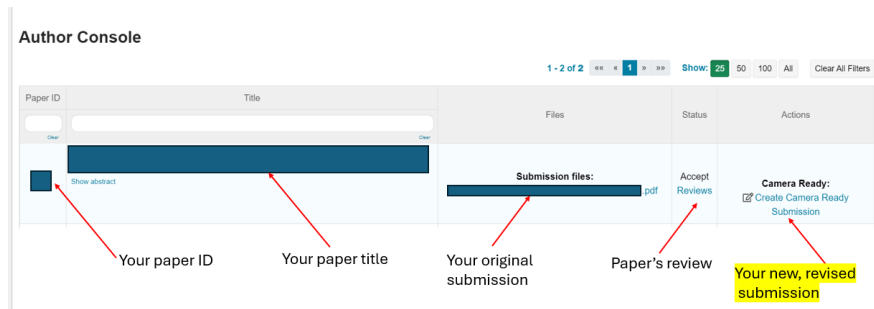


Figure 3. CMT author console

- Once the formatting issues are solved and the reviewers' suggestions are included, if apply, click on the "create camera ready submission" button, as in Figure 3.

- Update your author information in the space in Figure 4, if needed, such as title, abstract, author information. Note that on this point, only minor changes are allowed in this metadata.

- Finally, upload your final version and submit it, as indicated in Figure 5.

In case of using the Latex template upload the article in .pdf format and the source files in .zip format.
